Two log in options:


- Log in: If you've already completed the registration process





New registration


Once you've clicked "Register":

Enter your employer/business before accepting the terms and conditions and then clicking "Submit".



Pending approval

Once self-registration is complete, the screen will refresh to a Pending Approval status.

An email confirmation will be sent as well.




Approval on hold

If access is denied/deactivated upon registering, you will see "Approval on Hold".

An email with this information will also be sent.

You will need to reach out to your Apple representative to investigate the hold.



You'll need to reach out to your Apple representative to investigate the hold.




Welcome to Relay

The basics: Homepage

Relay basics

Relay has two pages:

- The homepage
- The library

The homepage is where you'll select the products you want assets for, similar to browsing on an online store.


The library is where you'll choose and download the assets you want, similar to a cart.

Relay homepage

Featured assets

This includes recently launched products and services.

This also includes previously launched products and services that have asset updates.




Relay homepage

Assets by product family or service

This includes assets for launch products, as well as assets for previous models.


Accessories are also in this area.



The basics: Library

Relay library

Click on "Library" in the upper right corner of your top navigation bar.




Relay library

The Library is similar to a cart.

Your assets will be here once you select them from the Homepage.

If empty, you'll be directed to the Homepage to select assets.

If there is a blue dot in the Library icon on your top navigation bar, this indicates that there are assets in your Library.




How to find assets and guides

How to find launch assets and guides

On the homepage:

- Option 1: "+Add All" for all the latest assets.
- Option 2: "+Add" for a particular product's assets.


Assets, including relevant guides and accessories, will be placed in your Library.



How to find assets by product family, service or accessory

On the homepage:


- Scroll down to the middle of the homepage and click on the desired family.
- A pop-up will appear.
- Choose which item you want and click "+Add".
- Assets will be placed in your Library.



Actions: Selecting and previewing assets in your library


Actions: Selecting individual assets and previewing assets

- Go to the Library.
- Click on the down arrow to the right of the product line that you want to review.
- To find the Accessories for a product in your Library, scroll down further on the page to the Accessories section.




Actions: Selecting individual assets and previewing assets

- Under the product line, you will see asset types.
- Click the down arrow to see individual assets.
- Click on the individual asset (either the thumbnail or the file name) to see a preview.



Actions: Selecting individual assets and previewing assets

- In preview mode, you can zoom in or out with the bottom button.
- If the asset exceeds the height of the preview area, you may need to scroll down to see the entire asset.




Actions: Understanding the "cross product assets and guidance" folder

Important: Cross product assets and guidance folder

This folder contains assets that are shared across a product family.

This folder may contain:

- Copy decks
- Family product images
- Product family logo
- Guide
- And other items as warranted




Actions: Downloading assets

Actions: Downloading assets

Select the assets you want to download by clicking on the square buttons to the left of each group or individual asset.


Click "Download"



Actions: Sending assets to another Relay user

Actions: Sending assets to another Relay user

- Select the assets you want to send by clicking on the square buttons to the left of each group or individual asset.
- Click "Send".
- Insert the recipient's email address.
- Click "Send Assets".
- Relay will now ask if you want to send a notification email to the recipient(s).



Note: Sending assets to another Relay user

Once you send the assets, the recipient(s) will receive your email message, telling them to go to their Relay Library. Recipients will not receive a link to the assets; they must log on to Relay and go to their Library.

In their Library they will see the assets you shared, marked by a red dot.

In order to receive the asset from you, the recipient must:

- Already be fully registered on Relay
- Have already logged on to Relay at least once

Actions: Removing assets from your library

Actions: Removing assets from your library

Select the assets you want to remove by clicking on the square buttons to the left of each group or individual asset.


Click "Remove". You will be asked to confirm that you want them removed.

Once removed, you cannot undo your action.

To place assets back in your Library, return to the homepage to select assets.

If you have assets in your Library and you log out, they will be there when you re-log in.

There currently is no history log of assets downloaded or sent.





Relay support: Access via three locations


1. Top navigation



2. Bottom of homepage




